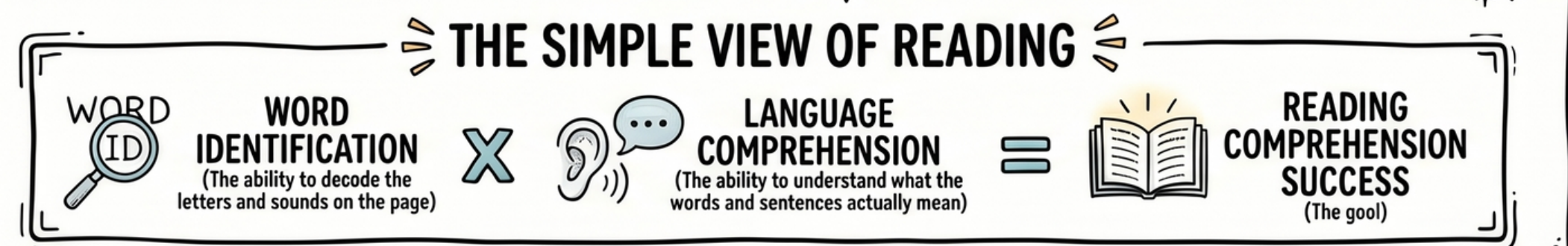
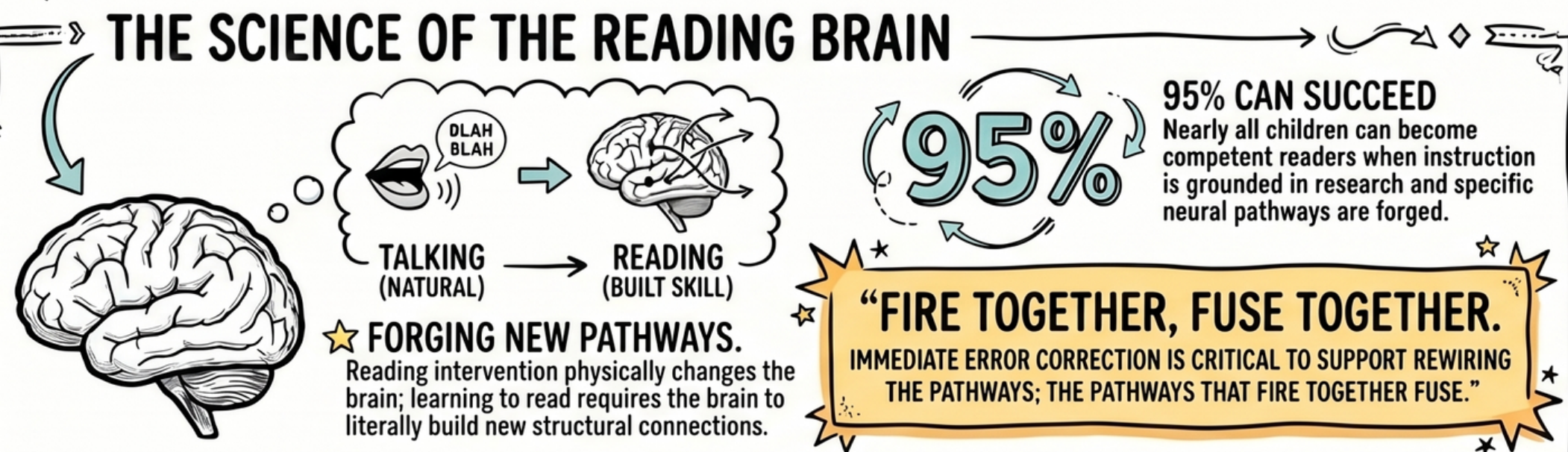


DECODING THE SCIENCE OF READING: A MENTOR'S GUIDE



WORD KNOWLEDGE MENTOR SHOULD KNOW

WORD TYPE	DESCRIPTION	EXAMPLES
HEART WORDS	Irregular or temporarily irregular words with unexpected letter patterns, best learned through orthographic mapping	said, to, was, is
ONE SYLLABLE WORDS	Simple words containing only 1 vowel sound.	beach, street, cake, big
MULTISYLLABIC WORDS	Longer words that can be broken into vowel units or “hums”	fantastic, calculator, basket
MORPHOLOGICAL WORDS	Words, composed of meaningful units, like roots, prefixes, and suffixes.	Jumped, Transport, unbreakable
